## Southgates Roundabout - Roadworks Update

### Week 3 – Monday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2010

Works continue to progress well at Southgates roundabout in King's Lynn.

New duct crossings have been finished in Hardwick Road and London Road, and the gas main diversion by Vancouver Avenue has started.



Works to widen Hardwick Road are also being done near Horsley's Fields. These will continue next week, with inbound lane closures between 9:30 am and 3:30 pm.

Next week works will also take place in Nar Ouse Way to lay new ducts for street lighting, electricity and traffic signals near the roundabout. Again lane closures will be used here, from midday onward each day.

The gas main diversion will continue at the Vancouver Avenue/Hardwick Road corner.

There will be various other pieces of work going on, including a small coring rig to take samples of the existing road construction to assist in specifying the new road build-up.

The Southgates project is one of the transport improvements that began in King's Lynn in 2009 after Norfolk County Council and the Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk secured £5.3m from the Government's Community Infrastructure Fund
