Southgates Roundabout - Roadworks Update

Week 22 – Monday 28th June 2010

Works continue on footways, street lights, signs and traffic signals, with poles now evident for the new pedestrian crossing in Hardwick Road:



Works will generally continue to be done under off-peak lane closures. Some of the traffic detector loops for the signals, which are cut into the road surface, are in locations where short-term stop/go may be needed, and these will be done during evening shifts starting at 18:30.

Scheme completion, including commissioning of the new signals, is expected in early August, ahead of schedule.

The Southgates project is one of the transport improvements that began in King's Lynn in 2009 after Norfolk County Council and the Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk secured £5.3m from the Government's Community Infrastructure Fund
